SCOUTING WORDS & TERMS

Rajonas	All the scouts groups in a country make up one large group.
Tuntas	Scout group for a particular area ie SA – Adelaides Vilniaus Tuntas.
Rajono Vadas	Head Scout for the country. At present the head scout is H Antanaitis.
Brolijos Vadovas	Head Boy Scout for the country. At present the head boy scout is N Ramauskas.
Seses Vadiėve	Head Girl Scout for the country. At present the head girl scout is Rasa Stakuvienė.
Tuntininkas	Head Scout for a particular group.
Adjutantas	Scout Group Adjutant – Tuntininko right hand person.
Izdininkas	Scout group Treasurer
Stovyklos Virsininkas	Head scout for a camp.
Stovykla	Scout Camp
Stabas	The group that is in charge of the Tuntas.
Draugininkas	The person who oversee the various sub groups within a Tuntas.
Skiltis	A sub group of scouts within a Tuntas. Usually a large scout group will have numerous Skiltciai
Skiltininkas	The scout in charge of sub groups.
Paskiltininkas	The scout in charge of a sub group.
Skautininkas	Green tie Scout. Usually leaders and older scouts. This tie is given on merit.
Vytis	Purple Tie Scout. Distinguished from all other scouts by their purple tie and their Vyciu Lazda (stick).
Vyresne Sese	Blue Tie Scout. Distinguished from other scouts by their tie being knotted.
Prityrusiu Skautas / e	Marone tie boy or girl.
Skautas / e	Yellow tie boy or girl.
Paukštyte	Red tie girl.
Vilkiukas	Red tie boy.
Gintareliai	White tie boy scout.
BUDEK – Vis Budziu	Scout sukis (saying). When someone says BUDEK you reply with VIS BUDZIU. The first word means are your ready, and your reply is Always ready.
Tyla	Lights out at Camp.
Raportas	Camp or Meeting Count at flag raising or lowering.
What to say at Raportas	Sese / Brolis Adjutantas /e šioje vėliaviu pakalimas / nuleidimas dalyvauja X Skautai. Dear Adjutant at this flag raising or lowering there are X scouts.
Sargyba	Camp night patrol.
Vėliavos Aikšte	The area where the flags are flown.
Skautu Isakymas	The scout ideal. Nelauk neiko is kito, bet viska duok ka gali. Never wait for anything but always give what you can.
Izodis	Scout oath given prior to receiving a tie. There are various versions of the scout oath depending on the tie, however in general it is :- Brangindamas savo garbe, as pasizadu visomis jegomis tarnauti dievui ir tevynei, padeti arkiturini vykditi skautu istatus. On my honour I promise to always honour God, Country, to help others and to always obey the scout rules.

Salutas	Scout salute. With either 2 or 3 fingers on the right hand. Vyciai with lazdaĩ. The salute with fingers symbolises the ideals given at the Izodis ie to honour God, Country and ourselves.
Didziuoji saluta	The salute given at izodziai with arms at 45°.
Malda	Prayer
Malda pries valgi	Prayer before eating Viespatie, palaimink mu sir tas dovanas, kurias valgysime is tavo malones. Per Kristu, musu Viespatie. Amen.
Vakarine malda	Padek, dieve kad rytoj buciau geresne negu sandien buvau.
Ateina Naktis	Scout Prayer sung at the end of Lauzas. Ateina Naktis Saule jau Nuslinko Nuo kalnu, nuo misku Nuo Lauku Saldziu Sapniu! Uzmikti Dievs yra cia. The night has come The sun has set From the hills and the forests From all the land Sweet dreams while asleep God is here.
