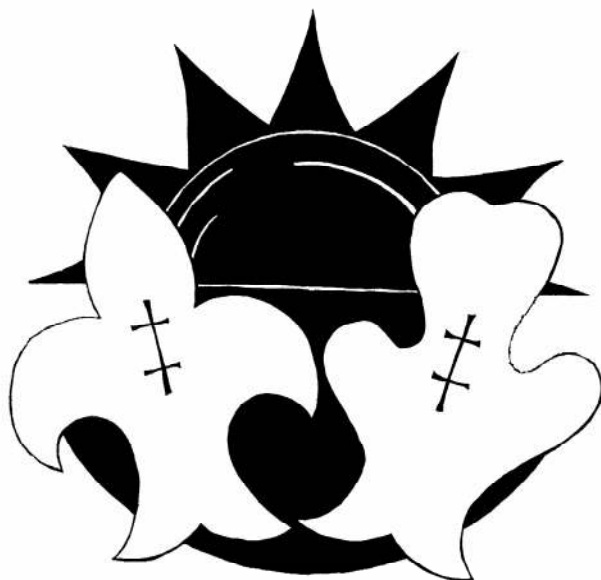

# **1. THE PROGRAMA**

## **I Patyrimo Laipsnis** **1<sup>st</sup> Level: 2<sup>nd</sup> Stripe**

**Must have completed II Patyrimo Prityrusių Skautų/čių laipsnį.**

### **1. Spirituality of Scouting**

- a) Discuss the similarities between the 10 skautų įstatus (scout laws) and the 10 commandments.
- b) Show examples of different types of Lithuanian crosses.
- c) Name 5 different churches in Lithuania.
- d) Name at least two religious historical places in Lithuania eg Kryžių Kalnas and explain their significance.
- e) Compose a short prayer.

### **2. General Knowledge**

- a) Explain the political structure of Lithuania today.
- b) Name 5 different Lithuanian organisations in Australia and outline their functions.

### **3. Lithuanian Scouting**

- a) What does LSS mean?
- b) What is a draugovė and a what is a skiltis?
- c) Show the structure of Australijos Rajonas, Name each member and briefly explain their role.
- d) Name the Tuntai in Australia, which area they represent and who is their tuntininkas/ė.
- e) Write a biography about Lord R. Baden Powell. Include information about when he visited Lithuania.

### **4. Lithuanian History**

- a) Write an outline of Lithuanian history beginning with Gėdiminas and finishing with independence in 1918. You may use point form.
- b) Write a brief biography about the following Lithuanian Dukes: Mindaugas, Gėdiminas, Algirdas, Kestutis, Jogaila and Vytautas. This should include their achievements. No more than a half page for each one.

### **5. Practical Scouting**

- a) Prepare a plan for a Weekend Stovyklą. What staff (štabas) do you need? Write the dienotvarkę (timetable and activities) for the entire stovyklą.
- b) Explain the different methods used to measure the height of a tree and the width of a river.
